

**MINUTES
SPECIAL JOINT CALLED MEETING
NORTHAMPTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
TOWN OF SEABOARD BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
APRIL 15, 2019**

BE IT REMEMBERED that the Board of Commissioners of Northampton County and the Board of Commissioners for the Town of Seaboard met on April 15, 2019 with the following present: Charles Tyner, Geneva Faulkner, Nicole Boone, Joyce Buffaloe, Kelvin Edwards, Geraldine Langford, Laquita Barnes, Alfred Kwasikpui and Verlene Stephenson.

Mr. Tyner called the Northampton County Board of Commissioners to order.

Ms. Langford called the Town of Seaboard Board of Commissioners to order.

Mr. Tyner and Ms. Langford made opening statements welcoming the respective Boards and those present.

Discussion:

After being recognized by Mr. Tyner, Cathy Allen, Tax Administrator, came forward and presented the Town with checks totaling \$69,046.61, representing ad valorem taxes due to the Town for the months of August through December 2018.

Ms. Faulkner then provided an overview of the Strategic Plan adopted by the Northampton County Board of Commissioners.

Mr. Kwaskipui requested the County's assistance in demolishing the old Seaboard High School building.

Ms. Barnes reminded those present that July 20, 2019 would be Community Day in Seaboard and extended an invitation to all.

Ms. Stephenson requested County assistance with grant writing.

Mr. Tyner highlighted the pending West Fraser expansion and the priority of seeking the voluntary annexation of the facility by the Town.

Citizen Comments:

Ms. Shirley Kwasikpui of Seaboard expressed her concerns about road holes and dilapidated buildings in the Town and inquired about the plans for the Coates Elementary building.
