NORTHAMPTON COUNTY CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROGRAM

Material	What To Recycle	How To Recycle	What Not To Recycle
Plastic	Only plastic soft drink bottles, milk and water jugs. Shampoo, soap, detergent containers. Plastic jugs labeled PET#1 and HDPE#2.	Remove cap, rinse bottle, flatten it and place it in the recycling bin.	No motor oil or any type of plastic container other than soft drink bottles, and milk and water jugs.
Tin and Bi-Metal	Steel (tin) and bi-metal cans, used for fruits, vegetables, soups, juices, pet food and other items.	Rinse out cans and put lids inside cans. Place cans in recycling bin.	No aerosol can, such as hair spray, shaving cream, spray paint, and cleanser cans. No cans other than cans used for food.
Corrugated Cardboard	Old corrugated cardboard used for moving and shipping.	Boxes must be flattened and placed in recycling bin.	Will not accept "waxed cardboard." Remove staples and any wire or plastic binding. No cereal boxes or pasteboard.
Newspapers	Magazines, junk mail, or office paper. Clean, dry newspaper and all inserts that come with newspapers.	Place newspaper and inserts inside in recycle bin.	No wet papers. No hard back books.
Aluminum	Aluminum beer and soft drink cans.	Empty cans. Place can in recycle bin.	No aluminum foil or pie pans, no cast aluminum products or pots.
Glass	All glass food containers. Clear green, brown (amber), or blue.	Remove lids and rinse out bottles or jars. Place bottles and jars in recycle bin. Paper labels do not have to be removed.	No drink glasses, mirrors, window glass, pyrex dishes, ceramic, light bulbs, or any glass that is not a container.
