

Your Vehicle Registration Notice has changed!

The North Carolina General Assembly passed a new law to create a combined motor vehicle registration renewal and property tax collection system. In doing so, the new law transfers the responsibility for motor vehicle tax collection from the 100 counties across North Carolina to the Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV). This new Tag & Tax Together program was designed as a convenient way to pay annual vehicle tag renewals and property in one transaction.

How to Pay the Combine Notice

You will make payment for both the registration fee and property to your local NCDMV or by using one of the following payment options.

- **Online** - Log on to: www.ncdot.gov/dmv and select registration renewal
- **By Mail** - Send a check or money order to the address listed on your renewal. Allow 4-6 weeks for processing.
- **In Person** - Locate a local registration renewal office (DMV)

PAYMENT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT THE COUNTY TAX OFFICE

Interest will be charged on late registration and property tax beginning the 16th day of the month following the expiration date.
