

SOCIAL WORKER
INVESTIGATIVE/ASSESSMENT/TREATMENT POSITION

Northampton County Department of Social Services has a vacant Social Worker-Investigative/Assessment/Treatment position, which requires working with abused and neglected children, their parents and the court system. Requires two to three days per month intake in the Services Unit and participation in the agency on-call schedule.

Minimum Training and Experience Requirements: MSW from an accredited school of social work and completion of the Child Welfare Collaborative; MSW from an accredited school of social work and one year directly related experience; BSW from an accredited school of social work including completion of the Child Welfare Collaborative and one year directly related experience; BSW from an accredited school of social work and two years directly related experience; Four-year degree in a human services field from an accredited college/university and three years directly related experience; Four-year degree from an accredited college/university and four years directly related experience; Masters degree in counseling from an accredited college/university in a human services field and two years directly related experience. May consider applicants who qualify for lower social work level. Salary is based on applicant's ability to qualify for full classification. Qualified applicants must complete a **State Application (PD-107)**, **enclose an official college transcript** and submit before the closing date to:
