BOARD DESCRIPTIONS

ABC BOARD

Meetings are every other third Tuesday of every other month beginning February.

3-5 member board to meet as needed to control the operation of the ABC stores under the General Statutes of NC.

CADA BOARD

Meetings is the Second Tuesday of the Month. Mission is to assist low income citizens achieve self-sufficiency and better quality of life.

CHOANOKE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Meeting is the Third Wednesday of the Month at 2pm at CPTA except July. Mission shall be to provide for a safe, adequate, and convenient public transportation system for the counties creating the authority and for its immediate environs, through the granting of franchises, ownership and leasing of terminals, buses and other transportation facilities and equipment, and otherwise through the exercise of the powers and duties conferred upon it.

HALIFAX-NORTHAMPTON REGIONAL AIRPORT

Meet the First Tuesday of every month at 5:30 Airport Conference Room. Goals/Objectives to govern the day to day operations of the airport.

COOPERATIVE EXT. ADVISORY LEADERSHIP MEMBERS

Meeting is held at least once a year, or more often as business arises. Promote the preservation of farmland in Northampton County so that development and growth will be accompanied by protection of farms from non-farm development and other negative impacts on properly managed farms, recognizing the importance of agriculture to the economic and cultural life of the county.

HERTFORD-NORTHAMPTON SMART START PARTERSHIP FOR CHILDREN

Meeting is held at center in Murfreesboro, NC on the 2nd Tuesday. To impact children ages Birth to five, in order to ensure a successful future.

HOME AND COMMUNITY BLOCK GRANT ADVISORY COUNCIL

Meet every Quarter on 4th Thursday at 10 am. To assure effective and efficient use of the Home and Community Care Block Grant through education, training, data and statistical review toward the development of a comprehensive and coordinated community based system of services, opportunities, and protections for adults aged 60+.

LAKE GASTON WEED CONTROL COUNCIL

Meeting are held in March, July location decided by President; Annual Meeting held in January location decided by President. The primary function of the Lake Gaston Weed Control Council is to establish policies and procedures focused on promoting research, control, and /or eradication of undesirable aquatic weeds within Lake Gaston and to improve the quality of the water related to pollution control in and around Lake Gaston.

(FOMOA) FRIENDS OF THE MUSEUM OF THE ALBEMARLE

The twenty-five (25) members of the Board of Directors of the Friends of the Museum of the Albemarle represent all thirteen (13) counties of the Albemarle region. The board serves as a support group for the Museum of the Albemarle by raising funds; advising the museum staff of regional expectations of the museum; and conveying information about museum exhibits, programs, and events to the citizens of their respective counties. Board members assist in recruiting and enhancing membership while serving their three-year term of office. The board meets monthly in either full board or executive session. The counties served are Bertie, Camden, Chowan, Currituck, Dare, Gates, Hertford, Hyde, Northampton, Pasquotank, Perquimans, Tyrrell, and Washington.

NORTHAMPTON COUNTY ANIMAL CRUELTY INVESTIGATOR

Recommended by Sheriff but appointed by Commissioners.

NORTHAMPTON COUNTY BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

Meets on the 3rd Wednesday of each month if there is business on the agenda. The meeting place is 100 West Jefferson Street in Jackson, NC. The purpose of the Northampton County Board of Adjustment is a quasi-judicial board that is tasked with considering and making decisions on variance requests, conditional use requests and appeals of the zoning administrator's decisions.

NORTHAMPTON COUNTY PLANNING BOARD

Meets on the 2nd Wednesday of each month (provided there is business on the agenda) at 6:00 PM in the Faison Administration Building located at 9495 NC 305 Jackson, NC. To operate under General Statutes 153A Article 18 and 160A Article 19, and those powers and duties as now or in the future may be delegated by the Northampton County Commissioners. The purpose of the planning board is to review and approve new subdivisions in the County. They also hear, and consider, testimony from applicants regarding items such as Special Use requests, proposed re-zoning actions and amendments to the various ordinances adopted in the County. The Board members consider this testimony and then pass along a recommendation to the Board of Commissioners for the request to be approved or denied.

NORTHAMPTON COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH

Meet the second Tuesday of each month at 7 pm in the Health Department Conference Room. To promote, provide and protect the health and safety of the citizens of Northampton County.

NORTHAMPTON COUTNY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE:

Meets every month on the Third Tuesday at the Visitor Center. The purpose of the Northampton County Chamber of Commerce is to advance the general welfare and prosperity of the county and surrounding area.

The specific mission is to promote economic, civic, commercial, cultural, industrial and educational interest to enhance the well-being of local citizens.

NORTHAMPTON COUNTY CULTURAL ARTS

Meetings are scheduled as needed. The purpose of is to make arts accessible to all citizens by preserving cultural and fostering to the growth and development of artist and the arts.

NORTHAMPTON COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

Meetings are held on the second Tuesday of each month at 5:30 p.m. in the J.W. Faison Auditorium. The Northampton County Economic Development Commission is responsible for initiating, organizing and managing the County's public sector efforts to strengthen the local economy, and create sustainable, higher-wage employment opportunities for the people of our county. In that work, the department partners with private sector, state and federal government allies, all focused on adding value to the business development interests of our citizens and business clients.

NORTHAMPTON COUNTY DSS BOARD

Meeting 4th Thursday of the month at 2 pm at DSS. The county board of social services shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

1. To select the county director of social services according to the merit system rules of the North Carolina Human Resources Commission;
2. To advise county and municipal authorities in developing policies and plans to improve the social conditions of the community;
3. To consult with the director of social services about problems relating to his office, and to assist him in planning budgets for the county department of social services;
4. To transmit or present the budgets of the county department of social services for public assistance, social services, and administration to the board of county commissioners;

NORTHAMPTON COUNTY LIBRARY BOARD

Meetings are held quarterly in the meeting room of the library on the second Monday of the second month of each quarter at 10:30 am (i.e. February, May, August, and November). The mission of the Board shall be to advise in the development and provision of library services to all citizens of its funding agency.

NORTHAMPTON COUNTY TOURISM DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

Meetings are held at Visitor Center, Jackson, at 4:30 at least one of year called by Executive Director/Chairman. The purpose is to promote travel, tourism, and corporate travel in Northampton County, sponsor tourist-related events and activities in the county, and finance tourist related.

NORTHAMPTON COUNTY RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD

Meet second Wednesday of each month at 5:30pm at the Wellness Center. The purpose of the Northampton County Recreation Advisory Board is to serve as a liaison between the Recreation Department and the citizens of Northampton County for all issues concerning leisure and recreation interests.

NORTHAMPTON COUNTY RECREATION AND CULTURAL ARTS CENTER, INC

Meet second Wednesday of each month at 1:30pm at the Wellness Center. The purpose of this group is for fundraising only. This group is a 501 3C that raises money for projects at the Recreational Complex and Cultural and Wellness Center.

TRI-COUNTY AIRPORT AUTHORITY

Meet once a month normally 3rd Wednesday at Noon. The purpose of the meeting is governing day to day operations of the airport.

ROANOKE-CHOWAN REGIONAL HOUSING AUTHORITY

Our board currently meets on the 4th Wednesday of the month at 2:00 p.m. here at the Gaston Office; 205 Tinsley Way. The Board operates under the Housing Authorities Law of the State of North Carolina and exercise its functions in its area of operation as defined in said Law. Northampton County appoints one commissioner to a 5 year term. Currently Ms. Jenkins has filled that position.

UPPER COASTAL PLAIN COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENT JOINT NURSING & ADULT CARE COMMUNITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The committee meets quarterly usually on the last Tuesday of the month during the 1st month of the quarter. Meetings begin with a training and business meeting at 9 am at decided Nursing Facility in Northampton County.

The Nursing & Adult Care Home Community Advisory Committee's primary function is to maintain the rights of residents living in nursing homes. The committee serves as the link between the community and the homes, seeking to increase community involvement and, at the same time, promoting community education and awareness of the needs of the resident in these homes. They receive training and technical assistance from the Region L Ombudsman. Members of the Nursing and Adult Care Home Community Advisory Committee visit Northampton County nursing home's quarterly to speak with residents to ensure their rights are being upheld as well as encourage nursing homes to participate in culture change efforts, such as, consistent assignment and offering more personal choices to their residents.

UPPER COASTAL PLAIN COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENT-NORTHAMPTON COUNTY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE & FULL BOARD MEMBERS

Meet every Quarter the 3rd Tuesday; varies locations at 5:30 for Executive Committee/ 7:00 for Full Board. Working under the direction of locally elected officials of these member governments, the staff plans and administers a variety of federal, state, and local programs and services. Monthly meeting are forums where officials determine priorities for the region of which their communities integral parts.

NORTHAMPTON COUNTY VETERANS ADVOCACY COMMISSION

The Northampton County Veterans Advocacy Commission is organized exclusively for educational purposes, more specifically to cooperate and promote with the County Veterans Affairs Service Center the development of an information and referral service for all services and programs for veterans, and commission members,

through their coordination, planning and monitoring, shall help ensure that the continuum of services throughout the County remains efficient and effective. Meetings. Unless otherwise scheduled by the Northampton County Veterans Advocacy Commission, monthly meetings shall be held on the second Wednesday of each month beginning at 10:00 a.m. at an agreed upon place.

TURNING POINT WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD

Meet bi-monthly-3rd Thursday at 6pm at 110 Fountain Park Drive Battleboro, NC. The Turning Point Workforce Development Board (WDB) is composed of leaders from the private and public sectors. This organization has the authority to determine how NC Works Career Centers, Workforce Investment Opportunity Act (WIOA) and federal/state Employment and Training funds are used in the Region. The board reviews, monitors and evaluates all programs and services and awards contracts.

TRILLIUM HEALTH RESOURCES

The Northern Regional Advisory Board meetings are held on the second Tuesday of every other month from 4pm-6pm at Roanoke-Chowan Community College, 109 Community College Road, Jernigan Building, Room 109, Ahoskie, NC.

The purpose of each Regional Advisory Board is to:

- Involve local stakeholders to respond to unique community needs and priorities;
- Promote understanding and collaboration at the local level; and
- Provide local participation in monitoring the performance and services within each region.

JUVENILE CRIME PREVENTION COUNCIL

Meet monthly except for July at 12:30 pm at Cultural and Wellness Center, Jackson NC. The purpose is to develop community-based alternatives to youth development centers and to provide community based delinquency and substance abuse prevention strategies and programs.
