Mission and Function of the Committee

- Review county ordinances as it relates to animals
- Identify and investigate options for managing animal control issues.
- Enforcement capabilities
- Strategic planning for animal care and control services
- Review the County's animal control history, current circumstances and identify trends

The Advisory Committee is to be appointed by the Northampton County Board of Commissioners and will meet to discuss recommendations for submission to the Board.

The Advisory Committee is to be made up of County residents interested in promoting safe and healthy use of spaces occupied by pets and pet owners. The Chief Animal Control Officer, Health Director, Sheriff, Commissioner(s), Veterinarians and PETA Representatives will serve as technical advisors to the committee.
