

## **To All:**

**Below is a link that counties can put on their websites to access the MyDMV Portal.**

Citizens will need NC Driver's License or NC Identification Card Number. Along with the Last 4 Digits of their Social Security Number, I-94 (Arrival/Departure US Customs Form) or Alien Registration Number, plus their birthdate. Once logged in, the citizen will see "Correspondence" on the right middle third of the window. Under "Correspondence", the citizen will be able to select the year for Vehicle Property Tax Fee paid or as pictured VEH PROP TAX FEE. Select the year desired and all vehicles paid for in that year will pop up with the total taxes paid for each vehicle in that calendar year. Businesses will not be able to access tax information through the MyDMV Portal.

To All: Effective February 20, 2017, customers now have the ability to retrieve the amount of vehicle property taxes that the DMV has collected from them for a given year through MyDMV portal. Once the customer logs into the MyDMV Portal, which is located on the main DMV webpage, and their personal information appears, there will be a correspondence section outlining each year the customer paid vehicle property taxes through the DMV. The customer would need to select the year they wish to receive the information. The system will then populate a tax statement that will outline the amount of vehicle property taxes collected for the year broken down by the vehicle and county in which it was paid. This tax statement can be also be printed by the customer for tax purposes
